## ORDER GRANTING PRO HAC VICE ADMISSION TO JEFFREY DANGEAU

This Commission rules as follows:

- 1. On February 15, 2021, pursuant to K.S.A. 77-536(a), the Commission issued an Emergency Order directing all jurisdictional natural gas and electric utilities to coordinate efforts and take all reasonably feasible, lawful, and appropriate actions to ensure adequate transportation of natural gas and electricity to interconnected, non-jurisdictional Kansas utilities. The Commission authorized every electric and natural gas distribution utility that incurs extraordinary costs associated with ensuring its customers, or the customers of interconnected Kansas utilities that are non-jurisdictional to the Commission, continue to receive utility service during this weather event to defer those costs to a regulatory asset account.<sup>2</sup>
- 2. On June 8, 2021, Mr. James G. Flaherty, an attorney in good standing and licensed to practice law in Kansas, motioned for pro hac vice admission of Mr. Jeffrey Dangeau on behalf of Black Hills under Kansas Supreme Court Rule 116. Mr. Flaherty states he will sign all pleadings and other papers filed with the Commission and will be actively engaged in the case and present for all appearances, to the extent required by the Commission.<sup>3</sup>

3. The motion includes Mr. Dangeau's verified application for admission pro hac vice

required by Rule 116. Mr. Dangeau verifies he is in good standing and licensed to practice law in

Arkansas, and is not currently, nor has he ever been, the subject of public discipline, including but

not limited to suspension or disbarment, in any jurisdiction. The verified application lists Mr.

Dangeau's address as 655 E. Millsap Rd., Fayetteville, AR 72703.

4. The Commission finds Mr. Dangeau has met the requirements of Rule 116 and

grants Mr. Dangeau admission pro hac vice to appear on behalf of Black Hills.

5. Mr. Dangeau shall be added to the mailing list, with service of electronic notices,

pleadings, testimony, orders, communications, and other documents.
