ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On May 5, 2017, Commission Conservation Staff (Staff) issued to Running Foxes Petroleum Inc. (Operator) a Notice of Denial of License Renewal Application.
2. On May 10, 2017, Operator timely requested an evidentiary hearing.
3. On May 18, 2017, the Commission issued its *Order Designating Prehearing Officer and Setting Prehearing Conference*.
4. On June 12, 2017, Staff filed a Motion to Close Docket, stating that “[a]ll matters have now been resolved to the satisfaction of Staff, which no longer wishes to contest Operator’s license renewal application. Staff has processed the application, and Operator’s license has been renewed.”¹ Based on the resolution of the matter, Staff asked that the docket be closed.²
5. The Commission finds that the granting of Operator’s license renewal warrants the closing of the docket.
