ORDER ADOPTING STAFF'S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) on the Application of Mid-Kansas Electric Company, Inc. for Approval of the City of Montezuma Firm Energy, Capacity, and Load Following Agreement. After review of the pleadings, the Commission makes the following findings and conclusions.

- February 1, 2018, Mid-Kansas Electric Company, Inc. (Mid-Kansas) filed its Application requesting approval of the City of Montezuma Firm Energy, Capacity, and Load Following Agreement.¹
- 2. On April 3, 2018, after examining Mid-Kansas' Application, Staff filed its Report and Recommendation, which recommended approval of the City of Montezuma Firm Energy, Capacity, and Load Following Agreement.²
- 3. After review of Staff's Report and Recommendation, the Commission finds that the Montezuma Firm Energy, Capacity, and Load Following Agreement between Mid-Kansas and the City of Montezuma is just and reasonable and benefits both parties.
