**ORDER DESIGNATING PREHEARING OFFICER

1. On January 24, 2017, Operator filed an Application to amend the above captioned injection permit.
2. On December 29, 2016, a letter of protest was received from Kristin Maun, Pittsburg, Kansas.
3. On January 6, 2017, the Commission Staff sent a letter acknowledging receipt of the letter of protest.
4. On January 23, 2017, a Certificate of Service signed by Ms. Maun was filed in the Docket.


