MOTION TO RESTRICT OPERATOR'S RIGHT TO TESTIFY AND PRESENT EVIDENCE

For the following reasons, Commission Staff moves to restrict Operator's right to testify and present evidence at the evidentiary hearing scheduled for February 20, 2017.

- 1. On December 20, 2016, the Commission issued a procedural schedule setting a January 27, 2017, deadline for submission of Staff's pre-filed testimony, and a February 3, 2017, deadline for submission of Operator's pre-filed testimony. Staff timely submitted pre-filed testimony, but Operator did not.
- 2. The Commission's December 20, 2016, Order states that failure to submit pre-filed testimony will likely result in the Commission restricting the right to testify and present evidence at hearing. Allowing Operator to testify and present evidence at hearing, despite Operator's failure to timely utilize pre-filed testimony, and the clear language in the Commission's Order regarding the likely consequences, would be both detrimental to judicial economy and prejudicial to Staff.
- 3. Therefore, pursuant to the Commission's December 20, 2016, Order, Staff requests that Operator not be allowed to testify or present evidence at the evidentiary hearing currently scheduled for February 20, 2017.
