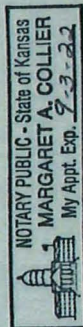

RE: Robinette Oil Company LLC Application for a permit to authorize the enhanced recovery of saltwater into the Zachariah Name/Well No. 5-90, 2-90 located in Jefferson County, Kansas.

TO: All Oil and Gas Producers, Unleased Mineral Interest Owners, Landowners, and all persons whomever concerned.

You, and each of you, are hereby notified that Robinette Oil Company LLC has filed an application to commence the injection of saltwater into the McLouth formation at the Zachariah Lease and Well 2-90 961 FSL 3968 FEL 5-90 330 FSL 4510 FEL; located in the SW/4 of the Sec.9 Twp. 9S R. 20E, Jefferson County, Kansas, with a maximum operating pressure of 1100 psig, and a maximum injection rate of 100 bbls per day.

Any persons who object to or protest this application shall be required to file their objections or protest with the Conservation Division of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas within thirty days from the date of this publication. These protests shall be filed pursuant to Commission regulations and must state specific reasons why the grant of the application may cause waste, violate correlative rights or pollute the natural resources of the State of Kansas.
