PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER REGARDING ELECTRONIC SERVICE

- 1. On November 14, 2019, Merit Energy Company, LLC, filed an application for an order authorizing the unitization and unit operation of the River Bend Chester Unit, Haskell County, Kansas, under K.S.A. 55-1301 *et seq.*¹
- 2. At a December 18, 2019, prehearing conference, all parties consented to the electronic service of all documents² and orders.³ Therefore, the Prehearing Officer directs that service of all documents and orders may be made by email.
