## MOTION TO REINSTATE INTRASTATE MOTOR CARRIER OPERATIONS

The Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Staff and Commission, respectively), by and through its counsel, files its motion requesting the Commission reinstate the Kansas motor carrier operations of Trevor Carlyle Tucker d/b/a Tumbling T Trucking of Healy, Kansas (Carrier). In support of its Motion, Staff states as follows:

- 1. Carrier is a motor carrier, as defined in 49 C.F.R. Part 390.5 and as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f, that operates commercial motor vehicle(s) in intrastate commerce.
- 2. Carrier is registered as a motor carrier with the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) and operates under USDOT Number 3781233.
- 3. On October 31, 2023, the Commission issued an Order Suspending Intrastate Motor Carrier Operations,<sup>1</sup> other than such motor carrier operations excepted from the Commission's regulation under K.S.A. 66-1,129, due to non-compliance with a Penalty Order issued on July 20, 2023.<sup>2</sup> The Penalty Order assessed Carrier a \$300 civil fine for failing to pay its 2023 Unified

Carrier Registration (UCR) fees. The Commission's Penalty Order is incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this Order.

4. On April 16, 2024, Carrier submitted payment of the \$300 civil assessment and

submitted payment of their 2023 UCR fees. Transportation Staff (Staff) confirmed the payments

have been made as of that date and determined the carrier was now in compliance with Kansas

motor carrier safety statutes, rules and regulations pursuant to the above-referenced Penalty Order.

5. Therefore, Staff asks the Commission to find that Carrier has now complied with

the requirements of the above-referenced Penalty Order.

6. Staff also asks the Commission to reinstate Carrier's Kansas motor carrier

operations.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, Staff respectfully requests that the

Commission issue an order reinstating Carrier's Kansas motor carrier operations.
