MOTION TO REINSTATE INTRASTATE MOTOR CARRIER OPERATIONS

The Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Staff), by and through its counsel, files its motion requesting the Commission suspend Andy Bond, d/b/a Bond Trucking of Liberal, Kansas (Respondent) from all intrastate commercial motor carrier operations. In support of its Motion, Staff states as follows:

1. Respondent is a motor carrier as defined in 49 C.F.R. Part 390.5, as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f, that operates commercial motor vehicle(s) in intrastate commerce.
2. Respondent is registered as a motor carrier with the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) and operates under USDOT number 816017.
3. On December 10, 2019, Transportation Staff filed a Motion to Suspend Respondent's Intrastate Motor Carrier Operations due to it not complying with Ordering clause B of the Penalty Order issued to it on October 2, 2018. Ordering clause B. states the carrier must submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within the next 18 months."
4. On December 17, 2019, the Commission issued an Order Suspending Motor Carrier Operations of Respondent.

5. Transportation Staff has advised that Respondent has provided the documentation and information required to conduct a safety compliance review and is now in compliance with ordering clause B. of the Penalty Order.

6. Based on the presented facts, Staff requests the Commission issue an order reinstating Respondent's intrastate motor carrier authority operations.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, Staff respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order reinstating Respondent's intrastate motor carrier operations.
