MOTION TO RESCIND ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR LICENSE


The Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Staff" and "Commission," respectively) files this Motion to Rescind Order Denying Application for License ("Motion"). In support of its Motion, Staff states as follows:

1. On June 30, 2017, Matador, Inc. ("Operator") submitted an application for license renewal.
2. Upon review of the application, Staff believed the application did not meet the requirements of K.S.A. 55-155 and K.A.R. 82-3-120.
3. Following the receipt and review of additional information regarding this matter, Staff has concluded that Operator meets the requirements of K.S.A. 55-155 and K.A.R. 82-3-120.¹ Therefore, Staff requests the Commission rescind its August 1, 2017, Order Denying Application for License.
4. Should the Commission rescind its August 1, 2017, Order Denying Application for License, all matters pertaining to Operator will be resolved, Staff will process the license renewal application, and this docket can be closed.

¹ Specifically, Operator recently reimbursed the State of Kansas for the plugging of the Ward #5 well, resulting in Sage Oil and Gas, Ltd., no longer being out of compliance with K.S.A. Chapter 55 and Commission Docket 15-CONS-667-CSHO.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully moves the Commission to rescind its August 1, 2017,
Order Denying Application for License and close this docket.
