Dear Ms. Retz:

This letter is being filed for Midcontinent Communications in response to the Kansas Corporation Commission Order in Docket No. 17-GIMT-426-GIT, dated March 28, 2017.

In compliance with the Federal Communications Commission's Order No. 11-161, Midcontinent Communications is reducing its terminating interstate and intrastate end office and tandem switched transport access rates to the levels of the corresponding dominant incumbent local exchange carrier's (AT&T-Kansas') rates. Midcontinent's intrastate end office and tandem switched transport access rates in its Kansas Access Tariff currently refer to the corresponding interstate access rates found in the Company's Tariff FCC No. 1. Therefore, no change to Midcontinent Communications' Kansas Access Tariff is required. Per the FCC rules, Midcontinent Communications will be filing its revisions to Tariff FCC No. 1 on July 18, 2017 with the effective date of July 31, 2017.
