Supplement #25 to KCC No. 145



On May 30, 2025, Kaw Pipe Line Company has filed an application with the Kansas Corporation Commission requesting authorization for a tariff change which increases rates by 1.9976 percent to reflect the Order No. RM93-11-000 Notice of Annual Change in the Producer Price Index for Finished Goods issued by FERC on May 16, 2025 for the period starting July 1, 2025. Kaw last increased its tariffs on November 1, 2024.
