MOTION TO REINSTATE MOTOR CARRIER OPERATIONS IN KANSAS

Transportation Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Staff), by and through its counsel, files its motion requesting the Commission to reinstate Varco Motors, LLC of Denison, Kansas (Respondent) for all Kansas commercial motor carrier operations. In support of its Motion, Staff states as follows:

- 1. Respondent is a motor carrier as defined in K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 66-1,108, that operates commercial motor vehicle(s) in commerce.
- 2. Respondent is registered as a motor carrier with the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) and operates under USDOT number 1170641.
- 3. On February 29, 2016, the Commission issued Respondent a Notice and Invoice (Invoice No. H000560937) assessing Respondent a civil fine in the amount of \$300 for violation(s) of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations as adopted by K.S.A. 66-1,129 and implemented by K.A.R. 82-4-3, et seq., discovered during a routine motor carrier stop and inspection on February 22, 2016, by a Kansas Highway Patrolman. The Notice informed Respondent it was to pay the civil fine within 30 days of the date of the Notice, or request an administrative hearing.

- 4. On April 27, 2016, the Respondent filed a request for hearing, contesting the violation(s) set out in the Notice and Invoice.
- 5. On July 16, 2016, the Commission issued an Order Dismissing Request for Hearing due to the Respondent no longer wanting to contest the matter and agreeing to pay the fine.
- 6. On March 9, 2016, the Commission issued an Order Suspending Motor Carrier Operations in Kansas, due to the Respondent not paying the civil fine within 30 days of the date of the Notice and Invoice.
- 7. On March 9, 2017, Commission Transportation Staff received payment from Respondent in the amount of \$300.
- 8. Staff asks that the Commission find Respondent has complied with the suspension order dated March 9, 2017.
- 9. Staff recommends the Commission to reinstate Varco Motors, LLC's motor carrier operations in Kansas.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, Staff respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order reinstating Respondent's motor carrier operations in Kansas.
