### ORDER CLARIFYING PENALTY PAYMENT REQUIREMENTS

NOW, the above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed its files and records and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings:

- 1. On October 10, 2017, the Commission issued an *Order Finding Non-Compliance;*Penalty Assessment (Penalty Order) in this docket, finding that Chit Chat Holdings, LLC d/b/a

  Chit Chat Mobile (Chit Chat) failed to maintain compliance with its Kansas Universal Service

  Fund (KUSF) obligations.
  - 2. As a consequence, the Penalty Order assessed a \$1,400 penalty upon Chit Chat.
- 3. However, the Penalty Order did not describe where payment should be made or in what time frame. The Commission seeks to clarify this information.

## IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

- A. The Commission's October 10, 2017, Penalty Order is reaffirmed.
- B. Chit Chat shall make payment of its \$1,400 penalty within thirty (30) days of the issuance of this order. Payment shall reference this docket, 18-CHCZ-013-SHO, be made out to

the Commission, and mailed to the Commission's Fiscal Office, 1500 SW Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604-4027. Credit card payment may be made by calling the Fiscal Office at 785-271-3113.

- C. The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if service of this order is by mail, from the date this order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration of any issue or issues decided herein. K.S.A. 66-118; K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).
- D. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of issuing such further order, or orders, as it may deem necessary.
