#### PROPOSED DEFAULT ORDER

The Commission rules as follows:

- 1. On September 17, 2024, the Commission issued a Penalty Order against Operator in this matter. On October 10, 2024, Operator requested a hearing.
- 2. On October 15, 2024, the Commission designated a presiding officer and set a November 14, 2024, prehearing conference. Operator did not attend the prehearing conference.
- 3. Commission records indicate Operator has paid the penalty assessed in the Penalty Order and has transferred the wells at issue to another operator. 1
- 4. K.S.A. 77-520 provides that "If a party fails to attend or participate in a prehearing conference, hearing or other stage of an adjudicative proceeding, the presiding officer may serve upon all parties a written notice of a proposed default order, including a statement of the grounds." Due to Operator's failure to attend the prehearing conference, the Commission finds Operator has failed to participate in a stage of this adjudicative proceeding, and serves this Proposed Default Order.
- 5. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-520(b), Operator may file a written motion requesting this Proposed Default Order be vacated, stating the grounds relied upon, within seven calendar days after service of this Order.

## THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

A. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-520(c), unless Operator files a timely written motion to vacate this Proposed Default Order, this Order shall be effective.

B. If this Proposed Default Order becomes effective, then this matter shall be completed as follows: (1) the September 17, 2024, Penalty Order shall become a final order, and (2) any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration of this Proposed Default Order, pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).<sup>2</sup>
