PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER SETTING STATUS CONFERENCE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Prehearing Officer makes the following findings:

- 1. On October 4, 2018, the Commission issued a *Penalty Order* against Liberty Operations & Completions, Inc. (Operator), concluding the Operator committed one violation of K.A.R. 82-3-407 because a current and successful mechanical integrity test (MIT) had not been performed on the subject well.¹
- 2. On October 25, 2018, the Commission issued an *Order Designating Prehearing Officer and Setting Prehearing Conference*, scheduling a November 16, 2018 prehearing conference, which was subsequently continued as a January 25, 2019, status conference.²
- 3. On January 25, 2019, a status conference was held by telephone before Prehearing Officer Myers.³ All parties encountered technical difficulties with the status conference telephone system. As a result, all parties agreed to continue the status conference to Wednesday, January 30, 2019, at 9:00 a.m.
