This is a notice of a penalty assessment against Colt Energy Inc (Colt Energy) for violations of Kansas Motor Carrier Safety Statutes, Rules, and Regulations discovered during a compliance review conducted June 26, 2024, by a Kansas Corporation Commission Special Investigator. Penalties are assessed in accordance with the FY 2025 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix, approved by the Commission on June 27, 2024. For a full description of the penalty(s) and terms and obligations please refer to the Order attached to this notice.

IF YOU ACCEPT THE PENALTY: Colt Energy has been assessed a \$300 penalty. You have thirty (30) days from the date of service of the Penalty Order to pay the penalty. Please remit payment of \$300, through your personal account with the Kansas Corporation Commission's Kansas Trucking Regulatory Assistance Network (KTRAN) system located at <https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/>. If you have not received a letter from the Transportation Division assigning you a PIN, please contact that Division at 785-271-3145. You must have an account through KTRAN to pay the penalty owed.

The attached Order requires a representative of Colt Energy to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of the Order and to provide the undersigned Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance. A schedule of dates and locations for safety seminars can be found at the Commission's website http://www.kcc.state.ks.us/trans/safety_meetings.htm.

IF YOU CONTEST THE PENALTY ORDER: You have the right to request a hearing. A request for a hearing must be made in writing, setting forth the specific grounds upon which relief is sought. Colt Energy must file, within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order, the request for hearing with the Commission's electronic filing system found at <https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/>, and mail a copy of the request for hearing to the undersigned at the above address. If you do not have access to the internet, you can mail an original and seven copies of the request to the Executive Director at 1500 S.W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604, and mail a copy to the undersigned Litigation Counsel.¹

IF YOU FAIL TO ACT: Failure to pay the penalty of \$300 within thirty (30) days from the date of service of the Penalty Order or failure to comply with the terms of the Order, or in the alternative, failure to provide a timely written request for a hearing, will result in the Order becoming final and may result in additional sanctions of suspension and/or revocation of your motor carrier operating authority.

2. On July 8, 2024, Staff submitted its Report and Recommendation (“R&R”), attached hereto as Attachment “A” and is hereby incorporated by reference, recommending a penalty of \$300 to be issued to Colt Energy based on the frequency, timeline and severity of the violations discovered. Staff’s R&R indicates that as a result of the safety compliance investigation, the SI identified three (3) violation(s), accounting for one (1) count, of the Motor

Carrier Safety Regulations (MCSRs), which carries a penalty according to the FY2025 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix.²

3. Additionally, Staff recommends that Colt Energy be required to have a representative responsible for the Carrier's safety compliance attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, and provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance.³ A schedule of the dates and locations for safety seminars can be found on the Commission's website at http://kcc.ks.gov/trans/safety_meetings.htm.

4. Finally, Staff recommends that Colt Energy submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of this Order.⁴ Transportation Staff will contact the motor carrier at a later date to determine an appropriate time for this review.

5. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,108b, 66-1,111, 66-1,112g, and 66-1,115, the Commission is given full power, authority and jurisdiction to supervise and control motor carriers, as defined in 49 C.F.R. Part 390.5 as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f, doing business or procuring business in Kansas, and is empowered to do all things necessary and convenient for the exercise of such power, authority and jurisdiction.

6. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,129a, 66-1,130 and 66-1,142b, the Commission may suspend operations, revoke or amend certificates, and initiate sanctions or fines against every motor carrier and every person who violates any provision of Kansas law in regard to the

regulation of such motor carriers and persons, or who fails to obey any order, decision or regulation of the Commission.

7. The Commission has the authority, pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-237, to investigate an entity under the Commission's jurisdiction and issue an order on the Commission's own motion when the Commission believes the entity is in violation of the law or any order of the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. Colt Energy is hereby assessed a \$300 civil penalty for three (3) violation(s), accounting for one (1) count, of Kansas law governing the regulation of motor carriers, the Kansas Administrative Regulations and provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations, as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations.

B. Colt Energy is hereby ordered to have a representative responsible for the Carrier's safety compliance attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, and is to provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance.

C. Colt Energy is ordered to submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of this Order. Transportation Staff will contact the Carrier to set up the appointment.

D. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537 and K.S.A. 77-542, any party may request a hearing on the above issue(s) by submitting a written request setting forth the specific grounds upon which relief is sought. The request may be electronically filed with the Commission's electronic filing system at <https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/>, within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order, and a copy of the request mailed to the Litigation Division. If you do not

have access to the internet, you can mail an original and seven copies of the request to the Executive Director at 1500 S.W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604, and mail a copy of the request to Litigation Counsel. A hearing will be scheduled only upon written request. Failure to timely request a hearing will result in a waiver of Colt Energy's right to a hearing, and this Penalty Order will become a Final Order.

E. If a request for hearing is filed, attorneys for all parties shall enter their appearances in Commission proceedings by giving their names and addresses for the record. For civil penalties exceeding \$500, a corporation shall appear before the Commission by its attorney, unless waived by the Commission for good cause shown and a determination that such waiver is in the public interest.⁵ For civil penalties of \$500 or less, a corporation may appear by a duly authorized representative of the corporation.⁶

F. If you do not request a hearing, the payment of the civil penalty of \$300 is due in thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Order. Payment of \$300 must be made through your personal account with the Kansas Corporation Commission's Kansas Trucking Regulatory Assistance Network (KTRAN) system located at <https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/>. You must have an account through KTRAN to pay the penalty.

G. Failure to pay the \$300 civil penalty within thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Penalty Order and/or failure to comply with the provisions of this Order may result in suspension of Colt Energy's motor carrier operating authority without further notice.⁷ Additionally, the Commission may impose further sanctions to include, but not limited to, the issuance and enforcement of revocation of authority and/or cease and desist orders, and any other remedies available to the Commission by law, without further notice.

In the Matter of the Investigation of Colt Energy Inc of Iola, Kansas Regarding the Violation of the Motor Carrier Rules and Regulations and the Commission's Authority to Impose Penalties, Sanctions and/or the Revocation of Motor Carrier Authority

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Colt Energy Inc is a motor carrier (MC) possessing private operating authority from the Commission, primarily hauling general freight and motor vehicles. Colt Energy Inc operates under USDOT 383678. On June 26, 2024, a Commission Staff Special Investigator (SI) completed a safety compliance investigation of the operations of Colt Energy Inc. A copy of the safety compliance report is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and is hereby incorporated by reference. As a result of this investigation, the SI identified three (3) violations, accounting for one (1) specific count, of the Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (MCSRs), which carries a penalty according to the FY2025 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix approved by the Commission. Based on the frequency, timeline and severity of the violations discovered by the SI, staff recommends penalty of \$300 be issued to the MC.

DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS:

On June 26, 2024, a Commission Staff SI conducted a safety compliance investigation of the operations of Colt Energy Inc. The investigation covers a 365 day period. Each specific count is detailed below.

Count One (1 of 1)

Jurisdiction: 49 C.F.R. 382.701(b), adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3c, and authorized by K.S.A. 66-1,129.

Intent of Law: The MC must conduct an annual inquiry into its drivers with the FMCSA Drug and Alcohol Clearinghouse (DACH).

Supporting Documents: On March 21, 2024, Colt Energy Inc required or permitted its driver, Jeremy Craft, to operate a commercial driver's license (CDL) required commercial motor vehicle (CMV), a 1995 Mack truck, VIN ending in 7335, GVWR of over 33,000 lbs., in intrastate commerce from Yates Center, Kansas to Iola, Kansas. This transport is evidenced by Kansas Motor Vehicle Crash Report No. 20224003366 and Driver/Vehicle Examination Report No. KSHP01762780, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**. The DACH report for this carrier is attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**. Mr. Craft's most recent annual queries were completed on February 28, 2023 and March 29, 2024. At the time of this transport, it had been over a year since his previous annual query.

Violation: Colt Energy Inc. failed to conduct an annual inquiry into its drivers with the FMCSA (**Exhibit 1, Page 3**). Three (3) violations were discovered.

Recommendation: Staff recommends a fine of \$300.

RECOMMENDATION:

Transportation Staff recommends the Commission find Colt Energy Inc committed three (3) violations, accounting for one (1) specific count, of Kansas law that governs MCs, including various provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (FMCSRs), as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations (K.A.R.s), and is therefore subject to sanctions or fines imposed by the Commission.

Due to the frequency, timeline and severity of the violations, Staff recommends a civil penalty of \$300 for three (3) violations of the MC Safety Statutes, Rules and Regulations, in accordance with the recommended penalties listed in the applicable Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix.

Staff further recommends Colt Energy Inc require a representative responsible for the company's safety to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of the Order, and provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance. A schedule of the dates and locations for safety seminars can be found on the Commission's website at http://kcc.ks.gov/trans/safety_meetings.htm.

Finally, Staff recommends that Colt Energy Inc submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of the Penalty Order. Transportation Staff will contact the motor carrier at a later date to determine an appropriate time for the review.

This carrier failed to ensure that DACH responsibilities were complied with. They also failed to complete required alcohol testing as required under Part 382.303(a) of the CFR. Alcohol test was not conducted after fatal accident.

Specific Recommended Remedies

To implement Safety Improvement Practices, the following list are recommended practices related to Roles and Responsibilities:

1. Ensure that managers are responsible for ascertaining that employees receive training concerning controlled substances and alcohol in accordance with State or Federal regulations and company policy.
2. Regardless of carrier membership in a consortium, ensure that the carrier defines and documents the role and responsibilities of the designated employer representative (DER) in monitoring test procedures and checking results.
3. If the carrier elects to join a consortium, ensure that the respective roles and responsibilities of the carrier and the consortium for controlled-substance and alcohol testing and reporting are defined and documented.

BASIC: Driver Fitness

Process Breakdown: Roles and Responsibilities

Specific Recommended Remedies

To implement Safety Improvement Practices, the following list are recommended practices related to Roles and Responsibilities:

1. Define and document the role of managers and supervisors for implementing driver-fitness policies and for monitoring compliance with them. This should include regular evaluation of the carrier’s driver-wellness program.

9. **Recommendation for general and monetary penalties**

The KCC requires that you prepare a corrective action plan, addressing the measures taken to correct all the violations identified within this report. Submit this letter within 30 days outlining the carrier's updated changes to their policies and procedures regarding all listed violations. Explain in detail how, as a carrier representative, you will rectify these deficiencies and prevent their reoccurrence going forward. Include any supporting documentation and evidence as indicated in the recommendations above, (example: vehicle inspections performed, proof of drug and alcohol testing in place, etc.) required to prove that corrective action has been taken. 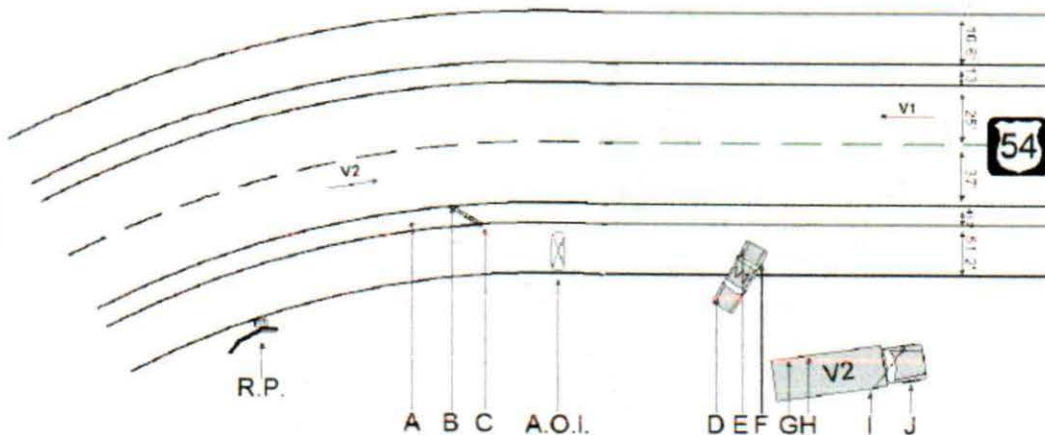
