ORDER 2: ARBITRATOR'S ORDER SETTING PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE

The above-captioned matter comes before Arbitrator Cynthia Claus, appointed by the State Corporation Commission (Commission) for consideration and decision with respect to a pre-hearing conference. After considering the files and being duly advised in the premises, the Arbitrator finds and concludes:

Level 3 Communications, LLC ("Level 3") filed a Petition for Arbitration on May
25, 2004. Level 3 requested arbitration of unresolved issues arising from interconnection
negotiations between Level 3 and SBC Communications, Inc. ("SBC").

2. 47 U.S.C. § 252(b)(4)(C) requires state commissions to "conclude resolution of unresolved issues not later than 9 months after the date on which the local exchange carrier received the request under this section." Level 3 explains that the parties have agreed to several extensions of time during the negotiations. Level 3 references a letter from SBC to Level 3 dated April 23, 2004, indicating the parties agreement that the "arbitration window shall close in the following states on the following dates:...." Appendix A to Petition. For Kansas the window closed on May 25, 2004, the date Level 3 filed its Petition. 47 U.S.C. § 252(b)(1) establishes the arbitration window from the 135th through the 160th day. Level 3 calculates the arbitration must

be concluded with an order by the Commission by September 12, 2004, to comply with the statutory time lines.

3. On June 10, 2004, the Commission issued Order 1, in which it appointed Cynthia Claus to serve as Arbitrator. Order 1 directed the Arbitrator to hold a pre-hearing conference before the end of June 2004.

4. The Commission Staff has reported to the Arbitrator that the parties have agreed to attend a pre-hearing conference on June 28, 2004. The Arbitrator concurs with that agreement and instructs the parties to attend the pre-hearing to be held at 1:30 p.m. on that date in the Commission's 3rd Floor Hearing Room.

5. The purpose of the pre-hearing will be to develop a procedural schedule, discuss discovery issues, and address the process that will be used to conduct the hearing.

6. The parties are reminded that the Arbitrator must submit her order to the Commission on or before August 13, 2004. Therefore, the Arbitrator anticipates that a hearing will have to be concluded by mid-July. The parties should begin developing pre-filed direct testimony in anticipation of a filing date for that testimony in early July. Because the testimony will be due so soon, time for discovery will be limited. The parties should discuss any discovery issues in an attempt to resolve them prior to the pre-hearing.
