ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

NOW, the above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission") for consideration and decision. Having reviewed its files and records and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings:

- 1. On August 27, 2013, the Commission issued an order opening this docket titled Order Opening Docket; Requiring KUSF Data Submissions; Procedural Schedule; Protective Order; Discovery Order; General Service Matters (Opening Order).
- 2. The Opening Order required carriers contributing to the Kansas Universal Service Fund (KUSF) and carriers receiving KUSF funds to file certain data in the docket by October 18, 2013 and deliver the same data electronically to Commission Staff (Staff).
- 3. On October 18, 2013, WestLink Communications, LLC (WestLink) and United Wireless Communications, Inc. (United Wireless) collectively filed a motion to extend the required filing date from October 18, 2013 to October 25, 2013 for their submissions.
- 4. WestLink and United Wireless's motion states that United Wireless acquired WestLink on August 9, 2013. The motion states that due to the acquisition, WestLink and United Wireless were both transitioned to a new billing system which the companies are still

becoming accustomed to. The motion also states that a key person involved in the task of

making the required data submissions has been ill and unable to work, and a family emergency

occurred on October 18, 2013 further affecting the work.

5. WestLink and United Wireless have communicated their issues with Staff, and

Staff does not object to the requested extension.

6. K.A.R. 82-1-217(b) allows the Commission discretion to grant extensions for

good cause shown.

7. The Commission finds that under the circumstances described above, the

extension should be granted.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. The motion for an extension of time from October 18, 2013 to October 25, 2013

filed by WestLink and United Wireless is granted.

B. The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if service of this order is by

mail, from the date this order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration

of any issue or issues decided herein. K.S.A. 66-118b; K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the

purpose of issuing such further order, or orders, as it may deem necessary.
