**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF REVISIONS**

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and determination. Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On July 25, 2011, Mid-America Pipeline Company, LLC (MAPL) requested Commission approval to establish rates for transportation service under K.S.A. 66-117, K.S.A. 66-1,217, and K.A.R. 82-10-2. Application, Motion for Temporary Waiver of Filing Requirement, and Request for Interim Rates Subject to Refund, July 25, 2011 (Application). The Commission granted MAPL's request to temporarily waive commencement of the 30-day and 240-day time periods provided under K.S.A. 66-117 for review of MAPL's Application until August 19, 2011, to allow for MAPL to file its testimony in this matter. Order Granting Motion(s) for Temporary Waiver of Filing Requirement of K.A.R. 82-10-2 and Waiver of 30-Day Notice Requirement of K.A.R. 82-1-214; and Agreeing to Temporary Waiver of Time Periods Provided for under K.S.A. 66-117, August 17, 2011.

2. On August 19, 2011, MAPL filed testimony in this case requesting establishment of initial general commodity transportation rates for its Conway to Coffeyville and Coffeyville to El Dorado segments.

3. Coffeyville Resources Refining & Marketing, LLC (CRRM) was granted intervention in this proceeding. Prehearing Officer Order Granting Intervention to Coffeyville Resources Refining & Marketing, LLC, August 30, 2011.

4. On April 3, 2012, the Commission convened the scheduled evidentiary hearing in this matter and upon the motion of MAPL and CRRM (Joint Parties), converted the evidentiary hearing into a settlement hearing. In the settlement hearing, the Commission approved the Joint Parties' joint motion for approval of the proposed settlement agreement, contingent on Staff's review of MAPL filing of Pipeage Agreements and Tariffs due to the Commission on or before April 17, 2012. Transcript of Proceedings, April 3, 2012, page 36.

5. On April 17, 2012, MAPL and CRRM filed a Joint Motion requesting the Commission approve the two pipeage agreements and supporting tariff sheets for the MAPL Inbound and Outbound lines, which were attached to the Joint Motion. Joint Motion for Approval of Pipeage Agreements and Tariffs, April 17, 2012.

6. On April 30, 2012, Staff filed a report and recommendation, recommending the Commission approve MAPL's tariff identified as K.C.C. No. 13 as filed. Staff also recommended the Commission order MAPL to address outdated terms in its K.C.C. No. 12, by filing a new tariff which omits Item No. 300, no later than June 1, 2012. Staff further requested the Commission formally conclude that all issues in this docket have been resolved and therefore order this docket to be closed. Report and Recommendation, April 30, 2012, page 2.

7. The Commission adopts Staff's recommendation of April 30, 2012, as filed in its Notice of Report and Recommendation and grants the Joint Motion for Approval of Pipeage Agreements and Tariffs as filed on April 17, 2012. The Commission further orders that Mid-America Pipeline Company, LLC's tariffs become effective as the date of this Order. The Commission concludes that all issues in this docket have been resolved and orders this docket to be closed.

**IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:**

A. Mid-America Pipeline Company, LLC's and Coffeyville Resources Refining & Marketing, LLC's Joint Motion for Approval of Pipeage Agreements and Tariffs is hereby granted, and K.C.C. No. 13 tariff revisions are hereby approved and shall become effective as of the date of this Order.

B. Mid-America Pipeline Company, LLC is also ordered to refile K.C.C. Tariff No. 12 with the requested edits on or before June 1, 2012, as set forth in Staff's Report and Recommendation and discussed above.

C. The Commission orders service of this Order be made by electronic mail, with a note that no hard copy of this Order will follow. K.S.A. 77-607(b)(2). Parties have 15 days from the date of electronic service of this Order in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration. K.S.A. 66-118b; K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 77-529(a)(1).


D. The Commission concludes that all issues in this docket have been resolved and orders this docket to be closed.

E. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further order, or orders as it may deem necessary.

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
