**PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER CONTINUING PREHEARING CONFERENCE**

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Prehearing Officer makes the following findings:

1. On January 24, 2017, the Commission designated a Prehearing Officer to address any scheduling or procedural matters pursuant to K.S.A. 77-517(b).
2. On February 9, 2017, at the Prehearing Conference in this matter, the Parties agreed to continue the Prehearing Conference until **Friday, April 7, 2017, at 9:00 a.m.**
3. On February 16, 2017, a Prehearing Officer Order Continuing [the] Prehearing Conference was filed in this docket, rescheduling the Prehearing Conference for April 7, 2017. However, due to a subsequent scheduling conflict, the Parties have agreed to hold the Prehearing Conference on **Thursday, April 6, 2017, at 9:00 a.m.**

**THEREFORE, THE PREHEARING OFFICER ORDERS:**

- A. The Prehearing Conference shall be rescheduled for **Thursday, April 6, 2017, at 9:00 a.m.** by telephone. The conference call information is: telephone number: (866) 620-7326, Conference Code PIN: 7632914771#.

B. At the Prehearing Conference, parties shall be prepared to discuss deadlines for filing testimony and briefs, discovery procedures, and scheduling of a hearing with the Commission.

C. At the Prehearing Conference, without further notice, this proceeding may be converted into a conference hearing or a summary proceeding for disposition of this matter as provided by the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA).<sup>1</sup> Any party that fails to attend or participate in the Prehearing Conference, hearing, or other stage of this proceeding may be held in default pursuant to the KAPA.<sup>2</sup>

D. A corporation shall appear before the Commission by its attorney.<sup>3</sup>

E. Parties have 15 days from the date of electronic service of this Order to petition for reconsideration.<sup>4</sup>

F. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
