ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings:

1. On April 24, 2019, Prairie Land Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Prairie Land) filed an Application requesting approval to update its Local Access Delivery Service (LADS) tariff.¹
2. On May 2, 2019, the Kansas Power Pool (KPP) petitioned to intervene.
3. On May 14, 2019, Susan B. Cunningham entered her appearance on behalf of Kansas Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. (KEPCo).
4. On May 15, 2019, Prairie Land, KEPCo, the Kansas Power Pool (KPP), and Commission Utilities Staff (Staff) (collectively, Joint Movants) filed a Joint Motion for Procedural Schedule, recommending an agreed schedule to the Commission for its review and approval.² Having reviewed the Joint Motion, the Commission adopts the following schedule:

5. On May 30, 2019, KPP was granted intervention.³

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

A. The procedural schedule in paragraph 4 above is adopted.

B. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).⁴

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering further orders as it deems necessary.
