ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On January 24, 2017, the Commission issued an Order to Show Cause, Designating a Prehearing Officer, and Setting a Prehearing Conference scheduling a Prehearing Conference for February 21, 2017.¹
