**APPLICATION FOR INTERVENTION ON BEHALF OF
KANSAS INDUSTRIAL CONSUMERS GROUP, INC (KIC),
SPIRIT AEROSYSTEMS (SPIRIT), OCCIDENTAL
CHEMICAL CORPORATION (OXY) AND
ASSOCIATED PURCHASING SERVICES CORPORATION (APS)**

COMES NOW KIC, Spirit, Oxy, and APS and respectfully files this Application for Intervention in the above-referenced matter before the State Corporation Commission of the state of Kansas (“Commission” or “KCC”).

1. On February 17, 2022, Evergy Kansas Central, Inc. and Evergy Kansas South, Inc. (together as “Evergy Kansas Central”) (“Evergy”) filed with the Kansas Corporation Commission an updated Transmission Delivery Charge (“TDC”) tariff in accordance with K.S.A. 66-1237.

2. Spirit, Oxy, and APS are direct retail purchasers of electric energy from Evergy, and APS is the group purchasing organization on behalf of The Kansas Hospital Association (KHA). Many members of KHA are direct retail purchasers of electric energy from Evergy.

3. Spirit, Oxy, and APS will participate in this docket through KIC. On numerous occasions in the past, the Commission has granted intervenor status to KIC, Spirit, Oxy, and APS in matters related to Evergy.

4. Spirit, Oxy, and APS and KIC will be directly affected by any amounts permitted to be passed through to retail electric customers of Evergy, by KCC Order in this case.

5. The KCC has permitted the following pass through of Transmission Delivery Charges (TDC) in prior years as follows:


