### PENALTY ORDER

)

The Commission finds Operator has violated K.A.R. 82-3-604 at the captioned lease, assesses a \$500 penalty, directs Operator to come into compliance, and further rules as more fully described below.

### I. JURISDICTION

1. K.S.A. 74-623 provides the Commission exclusive jurisdiction and authority to regulate oil and gas activities in Kansas. K.S.A. 55-152 provides the Commission with jurisdiction to regulate the construction, operation, and abandonment of any well, and also the protection of the usable water of this state from any actual or potential pollution from any well. The Commission has licensing authority pursuant to K.S.A. 55-155.

2. K.S.A. 55-162 and K.S.A. 55-164 provide the Commission authority to issue penalty orders for violations of Chapter 55 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, or of any rule, regulation, or order of the Commission. Under K.S.A. 55-164, a penalty order may include a monetary penalty of up to \$10,000, the penalty must constitute a substantial and actual economic deterrent to the violation, and each day of a continuing violation constitutes a separate violation.

3. K.A.R. 82-3-604(a) provides that each operator shall notify the appropriate district office within 24 hours of discovery or knowledge of any oil field-related discharge of five or more barrels of saltwater, oil, or refuse into an emergency pit or diked area.

4. K.A.R. 82-3-604(b) provides that each operator of an emergency pit or diked area shall remove any fluid from the pit or diked area within 48 hours after discovery or knowledge of a discharge, or as authorized by the appropriate district office.

5. K.A.R. 82-3-604(c) provides that for the purposes of the regulation, the point of "discovery or knowledge" shall mean the point when the operator knew or reasonably should have known of the discharge.

6. K.A.R. 82-3-604(d) provides that failure to timely notify the district office in accordance with subsection (a), or failure to timely remove fluids in accordance with subsection (b), shall be punishable by a \$250 penalty for the first violation, a \$500 penalty for the second violation, and a \$1,000 penalty and operator license review for the third violation.

### II. FINDINGS OF FACT

7. Operator is licensed to conduct oil and gas activities in Kansas and is responsible for the Horchem lease (Subject Lease), located in Section 27, Township 15 South, Range 26 West, Gove County, Kansas.

8. On September 27, 2024, Commission Staff discovered an unreported discharge in excess of five barrels into a diked area around the tank battery on the Subject Lease.<sup>1</sup> Commission Staff sent a Notice of Violation (NOV) letter to Operator on September 27, 2024, giving an October 11, 2024, deadline to clean up the discharge and submit a Report of Incident form.<sup>2</sup>

9. On October 14, 2024, Commission Staff conducted an inspection of the Subject Lease and found that fluid remained in the diked area around the tank battery.<sup>3</sup> Operator has also failed to submit a Report of Incident form.

### **III. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

10. The Commission concludes that it has jurisdiction over Operator and this matter under K.S.A. 55-152 and K.S.A. 74-623.

11. Operator committed one violation of K.A.R. 82-3-604(a) because Operator did not notify the appropriate District Office within 24 hours of discovery or knowledge of oil-field related discharges into the diked area at the Subject Lease. Under K.A.R. 82-3-604(d), a first violation of this regulation carries a \$250 penalty. Accordingly, the Commission concludes Operator should be assessed a \$250 penalty for this violation.

12. Operator committed one violation of K.A.R. 82-3-604(b) because Operator failed to remove fluids from the diked area at the Subject Lease within 48 hours after discovery or knowledge, or as authorized by the appropriate District Office. Under K.A.R. 82-3-604(d), a first violation of this regulation carries a \$250 penalty. Accordingly, the Commission concludes Operator should be assessed a \$250 penalty for this violation.

### THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- A. Operator shall pay a \$250 penalty for one violation of K.A.R. 82-3-604(a).
- B. Operator shall pay a \$250 penalty for one violation of K.A.R. 82-3-604(b).
- C. Operator shall submit a Report of Incident form for the discharge.

D. Operator shall dispose of any fluids remaining in the diked area at the Subject Lease.

E. If any fluids remain in the diked area at the Subject Lease after 30 days from the date of this Order, then Staff is directed to dispose of the fluids and assess the costs to Operator, and Operator shall pay an additional \$5,000 penalty.

F. Operator may request a hearing on the above issues by submitting a written request, pursuant to K.S.A. 55-164, K.S.A. 77-537, and K.S.A. 77-542, to the Commission at 266 N. Main St., Suite 220, Wichita, Kansas 67202, within 30 days from the date of service of this Order. <u>A request for hearing must comply with K.A.R. 82-1-219.</u>

G. <u>Failure to timely request a hearing will result in a waiver of Operator's right to a hearing. If no party timely requests a hearing, then this Order shall become final. If Operator is not in compliance with this Order and the Order is final, then Operator's license shall be suspended without further notice and shall remain suspended until Operator complies. The notice and opportunity for a hearing on this Order shall constitute the notice required by K.S.A. 77-512 regarding license suspension. A party may petition for reconsideration of a final order pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).</u>



### NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Following a lease inspection conducted <u>9/27/2024</u>, on the above captioned lease, it has been determined that you are currently in violation of the General Rules and Regulations of the Kansas Corporation Commission regarding the conservation of crude oil and natural gas. Specifically, you are in violation of K.A.R. 82-3-604. Each operator shall notify the appropriate district office within 24 hours of discovery or knowledge of any oil field-related discharge of five or more barrels of saltwater, oil, or refuse into an emergency pit or diked area. We are referring this violation to our Legal Staff with a penalty recommendation.

Each operator must remove fluid from the pit or diked area within 48 hours after the discovery of the discharge or as authorized by the appropriate district office. Removal of the fluid must be completed by 10/11/2024. Failure to bring the lease into compliance by that date will result in this matter being referred to our Legal Staff with a recommendation for an additional penalty and other possible action.

Enclosed is a Report of Incident form to be completed by the operator and returned to the District office by <u>10/11/2024</u>. *This form is for informational purposes only and not to be construed as to supersede regulatory requirements for reporting*. Your cooperation in this matter is appreciated.
