**NOTICE OF HEARING**

The hearing will be formal in nature and will involve both the rules of civil procedure and the rules of evidence. Please note that K.A.R. 82-1-228(d)(2) requires that corporations appear through an attorney.

Pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-229(c), parties will prefile direct testimony ten (10) days prior to the scheduled hearing date. One original and seven copies of the prefiled testimony must be filed with the Executive Director of the Commission, 1500 SW Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604. Rebuttal testimony may be presented at the hearing.

If any party(s) fails to appear and participate in this hearing, the Commission may proceed to hear evidence against the party(s) and enter such order as shall be justified by the evidence. Failure to participate may result in default judgment against the Respondent pursuant

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
to K.S.A. 77-520. Further, at any point in the proceedings, a proceeding may be converted into another type of agency proceeding pursuant to K.S.A. 77-506.
