TO: All Oil & Gas Producers, Unleased Mineral Interest Owners, Landowners, and all persons whomever concerned.
You, and each of you, are hereby notified that JTC Oil, Inc. has filed applications to commence the injection of saltwater into the Squirrel formation at the following wells on the Blunk lease, located in Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 21 East:
Blunk I-10, located 1603 feet from the South Line and 588 feet from the East Line,
Blunk I-11, located 1254 feet from the South Line and 220 feet from the East Line;
In Franklin County, Kansas, with a maximum operating pressure of 500 PSIG and a maximum injection rate of 400 bbls per day.
Any persons who object to or protest these applications shall be required to file their objections or protest with the Conservation Division of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication. These protests shall be filed pursuant to Commission regulations and must state specific reasons why granting the application may cause waste, violate correlative rights or pollute the natural resources of the State of Kansas.
