**ORDER RESCINDING PENALTY**

Upon its own motion, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

**I. FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On July 22, 2014, the Commission issued a Penalty Order in this docket, requiring Operator to pay \$1,000 for reported over-injection at the Whisman F #8.
2. Staff has reviewed this matter. It appears that there was a discrepancy in Commission records regarding the allowed injection rate at the Whisman F #8. This discrepancy has been resolved with Operator.
3. Based upon the above, Staff recommends that the Penalty Order in this docket should be rescinded.

**II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

4. Based upon the above, the Commission concludes that the July 22, 2014, Penalty Order in this docket should be rescinded.

**THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:**


- A. The Penalty Order issued in this docket is rescinded.


