APPLICATION

The Empire District Electric Company, d/b/a Liberty ("Empire"), pursuant to the Kansas Corporation Commission's ("Commission") Order dated September 25, 2002 issued in Docket No. 75-GIMC-009-GIG, page 5, paragraph 9, requests an order approving Amendment No. 1 to the Renewable Resource Energy Purchase Agreement between Elk River Windfarm, LLC, a Kansas limited liability company and Empire ("Amendment"). The Amendment is attached hereto as **Exhibit** A and is designated as confidential pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1220a. The Amendment has not been disclosed to the public and the parties to the Amendment have contractually agreed to keep such non-public information confidential because of the competitive nature of the wholesale electric supply industry. In support of its Application, Empire states as follows:

- 1. Empire is a Kansas corporation with its principal office and place of business at 602 S. Joplin Avenue, Joplin, Missouri 64801. Empire is incorporated in and is conducting business in Kansas and is qualified to conduct business in the states of Missouri, Arkansas and Oklahoma, and is engaged generally, in the business of generating, purchasing, transmitting, distributing and selling electric energy in portions of said states. Empire's Kansas operations are subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.

- 3. Empire entered into a Renewable Energy Purchase Agreement with Elk River Windfarm LLC, dated December 10, 2004, to purchase all of the electric energy generated by the 150 mega-watt ("MW") Elk River Wind Farm located near Beaumont in Butler County, Kansas ("Elk River Wind PPA"). That agreement is set to expire on December 15, 2025.
- 4. Empire and Elk River Windfarm LLC have entered into the Amendment. It extends the term of the agreement by approximately a 4½-year first extension period and a potential one-year second extension period. It also changed the contract price and monthly prepayment amounts and included a mechanical availability guarantee.
- 5. The Elk River Wind PPA's scheduled expiration date of December 15, 2025, aligned with Empire's IRP and its then-current capacity and energy needs. However, since that time, the Southwest Power Pool's ("SPP") resource adequacy ("RA") framework has changed materially; the Winter Planning Reserve Margin moved from no enforceable penalty for not meeting 15% to 36% within only a few years, with filings stating it would likely rise to 38% in 2029/2030. In that evolving environment, Empire had to preserve RA compliance in a way that remained least-cost for customers. Empire evaluated several interim options to bridge to new capacity and, on balance, an extension of the Elk River Wind PPA was the most practical "bridge" resource and one that also lowers fuel costs

for the next 4.5 years.

5. Approval of the Amendment will benefit Empire's customers. **

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WHEREFORE, Empire respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order approving the Amendment, and said further relief and authority as found by the Commission to be just and reasonable.
