**ORDER DESIGNATING PREHEARING OFFICER
AND SCHEDULING OF HEARING**

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Commission makes the following findings:

1. On May 7, 2019, Kansas Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. (KEPCo), filed an Application containing its proposed decommissioning fund plan to fund its 6% share of the decommissioning cost for Wolf Creek Nuclear Generating Station.¹ Attachment A to KEPCo's Application contains its proposed Funding Plan for the Commission's adoption.²

2. The Commission designates Brian G. Fedotin, Deputy General Counsel, 1500 SW Arrowhead Road, Topeka, KS 66604-4027, telephone number (785) 271-3105, b.fedotin@kcc.ks.gov, as Prehearing Officer in this proceeding.³ The prehearing officer may conduct any prehearing conferences necessary to address any matters appropriately considered in a prehearing conference, including all items listed in K.S.A. 77-517(b) of the Kansas

Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA). The Commission may designate other staff members to serve in this capacity.

3. The Commission will hold a hearing on KEPCo's proposed Funding Plan on Thursday, August 22, 2019 and 10:30 a.m. in the Commission's First Floor Hearing Room.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- A. Brian G. Fedotin is designated as Prehearing Officer.
- B. A hearing will be held before the Commission on August 22, 2019 at 10:30 a.m.
- C. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).⁴
- D. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties to enter further orders as it deems necessary.
