I received your letter dated Feb. 1 in the matter of Hopper Oil Co.'s application for injection authority E-17,207 at the Hammer #10 in Cowley, Kansas.

As you know, I am not an attorney, and as a private landowner representing only myself, I do feel a hearing should be scheduled in this matter.

I would note that I cannot be certain I would be requesting a hearing if the language of Hopper's published notice were not so misleading and meaningless.

Specifically, the activity the notice seeks authorization for, "the enhanced recovery of saltwater" is not an activity that I have been able to find defined anywhere in KCC, EPA or SWDA regulations and statutes.

Were the KCC to require that Hopper republish a notice that describes accurately the activity for which authorization is sought, I would be better able to make an informed decision about whether I am harmed by the granting of this authority.
