## **PENALTY ORDER**

The Commission finds Operator has violated K.A.R. 82-3-117 regarding the captioned well, assesses a \$100 penalty, directs Operator to come into compliance, and further rules as more fully described below.

#### I. JURISDICTION

- 1. K.S.A. 74-623 provides the Commission exclusive jurisdiction and authority to regulate oil and gas activities in Kansas. K.S.A. 55-152 provides the Commission with jurisdiction to regulate the construction, operation, and abandonment of any well, and also the protection of the usable water of this state from any actual or potential pollution from any well. The Commission has licensing authority under K.S.A. 55-155.
- 2. K.S.A. 55-162 and K.S.A. 55-164 provide the Commission authority to issue penalty orders for violations of Chapter 55 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, or of any rule, regulation, or order of the Commission. Under K.S.A. 55-164, a penalty order may include a monetary penalty of up to \$10,000, the penalty must constitute a substantial and actual economic deterrent to the violation, and each day of a continuing violation constitutes a separate violation.

3. K.A.R. 82-3-117 provides that within 60 days after plugging any well, the owner or operator shall file a well plugging report with the Conservation Division, on a form furnished by the Commission. Failure to file a plugging report shall be punishable by a \$100 penalty.

### II. FINDINGS OF FACT

- 4. Operator is licensed to conduct oil and gas activities in Kansas and is responsible for the Shue, Joseph V. #6-1 well (Subject Well), API #15-133-26900-00-00, located in Section 6, Township 27 South, Range 20 East, Neosho County, Kansas.
  - 5. On November 22, 2024, Operator plugged the Subject Well.<sup>2</sup>
- 6. Operator did not submit a complete and accurate well plugging report (CP-4) within 60 days of the plugging date.
- 7. On February 6, 2025, Commission Staff sent a Notice of Violation letter to Operator, requiring Operator to file a CP-4 by February 20, 2025.<sup>3</sup> The Commission did not receive a complete, accurate CP-4 by the deadline in the letter.

### III. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 8. The Commission has jurisdiction over Operator and this matter under K.S.A. 74-623 and K.S.A. 55-152.
- 9. Operator has committed one violation of K.A.R. 82-3-117 because Operator has not submitted a complete and accurate CP-4 for the Subject Well in a timely manner.

## THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- A. Operator shall pay a \$100 penalty.
- B. Operator shall submit a complete, accurate CP-4 for the Subject Well.

C. Operator may request a hearing on the above issues by submitting a written

request, pursuant to K.S.A. 55-164, K.S.A. 77-537, and K.S.A. 77-542, to the Commission at

266 N. Main St., Suite 220, Wichita, Kansas 67202, within 30 days from the date of service of

this Order. A request for hearing must comply with K.A.R. 82-1-219.

D. Failure to timely request a hearing will result in a waiver of Operator's right to a

hearing. If no party timely requests a hearing, then this Order shall become final. If Operator is

not in compliance with this Order and the Order is final, then Operator's license shall be

suspended without further notice and shall remain suspended until Operator complies. The notice

and opportunity for a hearing on this Order shall constitute the notice required by K.S.A. 77-512

regarding license suspension. A party may petition for reconsideration of a final order pursuant

to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).
