D. A corporation shall appear before the Commission by a Kansas licensed attorney.³

E. Parties have 15 days from the date of electronic service of this Order to petition for

reconsideration.4

F. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the

purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
