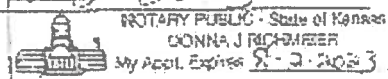

RE: HARTMAN OIL CO., INC. - Application for a second exception to the 10 year time limitation of K.A.R. 82-3-111 for the Tucker Adams 1 well, located in Finney County, Kansas.

TO: All Oil and Gas Producers, Unleased Mineral Interest Owners, Landowners, and all persons whomsoever concerned.

You, and each of you, are hereby notified that Hartman Oil Co., Inc., has filed an application for a second exception to the 10 year time limitation of K.A.R. 82-3-111 for the Tucker Adams 1, located in the NW1/4 of Sec 4-T22S R33W, Finney County, Kansas.

Any persons who object or protest this application shall be required to file their objections or protest with the Conservation Division of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas within fifteen (15) days from the date of this publication. These protests shall be filed pursuant to Commission regulations and must state specific reasons why the grant of the application may cause waste, violate correlative rights or pollute the natural resources of the State of Kansas. If no protests are received, this application may be granted through a summary proceeding. If valid protests are received, this matter will be set for hearing.
