PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER RESCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Prehearing Officer makes the following findings:

On February 26, 2019, the Commission issued a Penalty Order against Great Plains 1. Petroleum, Inc. (Operator) for one violation of K.A.R. 82-3-111 because the subject well had been inactive in excess of the time allowed by regulation without being plugged, returned to service, or approved for temporary abandonment status.¹

On March 29, 2019, Operator filed a request for hearing.² Two prehearing conferences 2. have been held; another was scheduled for June 13, 2019.³

3. On June 11, 2019, parties participated in a telephone call in which it was agreed to cancel the June 13, 2019, prehearing conference, and to schedule another prehearing conference for the latter part of July, although parties anticipate amicable, full resolution of this docket prior to then.

4. To encourage timely resolution of this docket, the Prehearing Officer finds rescheduling of the prehearing conference to be appropriate.
