3. Failure to submit pre-filed testimony may result in the Commission restricting the right to testify and present evidence at the evidentiary hearing. At the hearing, the Commission may limit the parties' direct and rebuttal testimony to the pre-filed testimony.

4. Any settlement agreement the parties wish to present for Commission consideration shall be due by May 6, 2019.

5. Any person requiring special accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities Act should notify the Commission at least 10 days before the scheduled hearing date.

6. Any party who fails to attend or participate in the evidentiary hearing or any other stage of this proceeding may be held in default under the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act.²

7. A corporation shall appear before the Commission by a Kansas licensed attorney.³

THEREFORE, THE PREHEARING OFFICER ORDERS:

A. The procedural schedule set forth in Paragraph 2 above is adopted.

B. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
