PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER
ADJUSTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Prehearing Officer makes the following findings:

1. Operator has requested hearings on the penalty orders issued in the captioned dockets.

These matters have been consolidated for hearing on a common record.¹

2. On January 22, 2020, the Prehearing Officer issued an order setting a procedural schedule. Commission Staff and Operator timely submitted their pre-filed direct testimony, but disruptions associated with COVID-19 have resulted in the need to adjust the remainder of the schedule.²

3. At a May 28, 2020, prehearing conference, parties agreed that Staff's pre-filed rebuttal testimony shall be due by June 19, 2020, and that the deadline to submit any settlement to the Commission for consideration shall also be June 19, 2020. The Prehearing Officer so orders it.

4. No evidentiary hearing is currently scheduled. The Prehearing Officer shall be in communication with the parties regarding further development of the procedural schedule.
