ORDER ASSESSING COSTS

1. K.S.A. 66-1502 authorizes the Commission to assess the expenses of an investigation, opened on its own motion, against public utilities if the expenses reasonably attributable to such investigation exceed the sum of \$100. The Commission will utilize members of its Staff in this investigation, and as deemed appropriate by the Commission, employ special assistants and consultants to investigate all matters connected with this proceeding. The Commission finds that the expenses reasonably attributable to this investigation will exceed \$100. The Commission concludes that the costs of this proceeding should be equally assessed to United Telephone Company of Kansas d/b/a CenturyLink: United Telephone Company of Southcentral Kansas d/b/a CenturyLink; United Telephone Company Eastern Kansas d/b/a CenturyLink; Embarq Missouri, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink, and Big River Telephone Company,

LLC. This order constitutes notice of the assessment of costs and the assessment will begin three days after the date this order is mailed. United Telephone Company of Kansas d/b/a CenturyLink: United Telephone Company of Southcentral Kansas d/b/a CenturyLink; United Telephone Company Eastern Kansas d/b/a CenturyLink; Embarq Missouri, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink, and Big River Telephone Company, LLC are given notice that they may request a hearing as to the necessity of the investigation or the assessment of costs, in accordance with the

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. United Telephone Company of Kansas d/b/a CenturyLink: United Telephone

Company of Southcentral Kansas d/b/a CenturyLink; United Telephone Company Eastern

Kansas d/b/a CenturyLink; Embarq Missouri, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink, and Big River Telephone

Company, LLC are equally assessed the costs of this investigation.
