**ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings:

1. On December 8, 2016, the Commission issued in this docket its *Order to Show Cause, Designating a Prehearing Officer, and Setting a Prehearing Conference*.
2. A Prehearing Conference was originally scheduled in this docket for December 14, 2016.<sup>1</sup> The Prehearing Conference was subsequently rescheduled for January 12, 2017.<sup>2</sup>
3. At the rescheduled Prehearing Conference, all parties agreed to the following procedural schedule:

Staff’s Pre-filed Direct Testimony	Due: February 20, 2017
Operator’s Pre-filed Direct Testimony	Due: February 27, 2017
Rebuttal Testimony	Due: March 6, 2017
Evidentiary Hearing before the Commission 266 N. Main, Suite 220, Wichita, Kansas 67202	March 16, 2017, 10:00 a.m.

4. Failure to submit pre-filed testimony will likely result in the Commission restricting the right to testify and present evidence at the evidentiary hearing. At the hearing, the Commission may limit the parties' direct and rebuttal testimony to the pre-filed testimony.

5. Any settlement agreement the parties wish to present for Commission consideration shall be due by March 6, 2017.

6. Any person requiring special accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities Act should notify the Commission at least 10 days before the scheduled hearing date.

7. Any party who fails to attend or participate in the evidentiary hearing or in any other stage of this proceeding may be held in default under the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act.<sup>3</sup>

**THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:**

A. The procedural schedule set forth in paragraph 3 is adopted.


B. The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if mailed service, from the date this Order was served in which to petition for reconsideration.<sup>4</sup>
