GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS APPLYING TO ALL CUSTOMER CONTRACTS

20. BILLING (Continued)

D. If approved by the subscriber, the Telephone Company may provide a bill through alternate means (e.g., electronic billing) and/or in an alternative format. The Telephone Company may offer discounts to those subscribers who choose to use an alternate means of billing, but will not assess an additional charge to those customers that elect paper billing. A paper copy of the subscriber's bill will be provided by the Telephone Company upon request, unless an electronic version is available to the customer.

E. Delayed Billing

Upon subscriber request, the Company will extend the payment period proportionately if a bill contains two or more months charges; all of which have not been previously billed.

21. PAYMENTS

- A. All bills are due and payable upon receipt.
 - The customer shall pay for services and facilities monthly in advance -- except as otherwise provided elsewhere in this tariff--shall pay for toll messages, non-recurring service charges, taxes, special service charges not authorized by tariff, additional charges and adjustments when billed.
 - 2) If the entire amount billed is not received by the Company prior to the next billing date, a late payment charge in the amount of \$10.00 or 5% of the unpaid balance, whichever is greater, will be assessed. This late payment charge will apply to all services on any unpaid balance. A late payment charge shall not be applied to any balance to which the charge was applied in a previous billing.
- B. All charges due by the subscriber are payable by the subscriber by means of mail or at any agency duly authorized to receive such payments.
- C. The customer assumes responsibility for all charges originating at equipment contracted for by him and for messages received on which the charges have been reversed with the consent of the person answering the telephone.
- D. Delinquency Date A bill shall be deemed delinquent if payment thereof is not received by the Company or its authorized agent on or before the date stated on the bill. The delinquency date specified on the bill shall be at least the tenth (10th) day after the date of the mailing of the bill to the customer.
- E. If the last calendar day for remittance falls on a weekend, Legal Holiday, or other day when the offices of the Telephone Company are not open to the general public, the final payment date shall be extended through the next business day.
- F. The Telephone Company may negotiate payment arrangements with subscribers. The Telephone Company may impose 900 number call restriction and/or toll restriction as part of the payment arrangement.
