ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings and conclusions:

- 1. On January 18, 2017, Commission Conservation Staff (Staff) sent Ernie D. Pratt (Operator) a Notice of Denial of License Renewal Application. Operator timely requested an evidentiary hearing.¹
- 2. On March 2, 2017, the Commission issued its *Order Designating Prehearing Officer* and Setting Prehearing Conference (Order), scheduling a Prehearing Conference for March 23, 2017.²
- 3. On March 21, 2017, Staff moved to reschedule the Prehearing Conference.³ Staff's Motion was granted by a Prehearing Officer Order on March 21, 2017, setting the Prehearing Conference for April 27, 2017.⁴
 - 4. The parties have agreed to the following procedural schedule:

- Failure to submit pre-filed testimony may result in the Commission restricting the 5. right to testify and present evidence at the evidentiary hearing. At the hearing, the Commission may limit the parties' direct and rebuttal testimony to the pre-filed testimony.
- Any settlement agreement the parties wish to present for Commission consideration 6. shall be due by August 7, 2017.
- Any person requiring special accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities 7. Act should notify the Commission at least 10 days before the scheduled hearing date.
- Any party who fails to attend or participate in the evidentiary hearing or in any other 8. stage of this proceeding may be held in default under the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act.⁵

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- The procedural schedule set forth in paragraph 4 is adopted. A.
- В. The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if mailed service, from the date this Order was served in which to petition for reconsideration.⁶
- The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the C. purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
