KCP&L KS July 21, 2019 Significant Event

This report has been prepared and is being submitted to comply with the Electric Reliability Requirements section 3, part N and section 6, part B of Docket 02-GIME-365-GIE.

Beginning on Wednesday, July 21 at approximately 1:00AM, extreme wind and lightning in the service area caused numerous outages in the KS territory of KCP&L. Most of the outages occurred in areas surrounding Johnson County.

The peak number of customers without power occurred within the 3:00AM hour of July 21 and totaled approximately 8,000 customers. These accumulated outages have been classified as a "Significant Event", having over 10,000 retail customers with sustained service interruptions in a 24 hour period.

Approximately 10,000 interrupted customers had been restored before 8:00 PM on July 21.
