- 1. On February 13, 2019, Commission Staff (Staff) filed a *Motion to Reopen Docket* and Change Docket Number for Administrative Purposes (Motion) asking the Commission to change the docket number assigned to this proceeding from Docket No. 16-USET-143-IAT to Docket No. 16-UTDT-143-IAT. Staff indicated that the change would provide consistency between other dockets involving CenturyLink as a collective, and aid Staff in finding information involving CenturyLink.
- 2. K.S.A. 74-629 allows the Commission to "organize the office...as it deems most efficient." K.A.R. 82-1-212 states that each matter coming before the Commission and requiring

a decision by the Commission shall be known as a docket and shall receive a docket number and a descriptive title.

3. The Commission finds Staff's request to be reasonable and hereby approves of the docket number change request. The Commission finds that such change will aid in the efficient operations of the Commission.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

- A. The docket number associated with this proceeding is hereby changed from Docket No. 16-USET-143-IAT to Docket No. 16-UTDT-143-IAT.
 - B. This docket is closed.
- C. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).
- D. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of issuing such further order, or orders, as it may deem necessary.
