Matrix Telecom, LLC ("Matrix") hereby submits this correspondence pursuant to the requirements in the Kansas Corporation Commission's Order issued March 29, 2017 in Docket No. 17-GIMT-426-GIT. The purpose of this filing is to affirm Matrix's compliance with the Federal Communications Commission's intercarrier compensation restructuring, WC Docket No. 10-90, *et al.*, mirroring interstate access rates and rate structures and the criteria set forth in 47 C.F.R. §51.911.

Matrix's intrastate switched access rates currently in effect in the State of Kansas are in parity and are assessed at interstate rates and rate structure pursuant to the Matrix's Federal Access Tariff, Tariff FCC No. 1. Accordingly, Matrix's Kansas Telecommunications Access Services, Tariff No. 14, reflects such and therefore, no intrastate tariff revision is required at this time.
