ORDER ON KANSAS ELECTRIC POWER COOPERATIVE, INC.'S <u>PETITION TO INTERVENE</u>

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings:

1. On November 13, 2012, Mid-Kansas Electric Company, LLC (Mid-Kansas) filed its Open Access Transmission Tariff (OATT) for Commission approval pursuant to the Commission order in Docket No. 12-MKEE-650-TAR.

2. Kansas Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. (KEPCo) filed a petition to intervene with the Commission on January 3, 2013 (KEPCo Petition), requesting leave to intervene in this proceeding.

3. KEPCo is engaged in the business of a generation and transmission cooperative electric supplier in the State of Kansas and serves approximately 300,000 consumer members.¹ KEPCo stated that takes transmission service from Mid-Kansas for service to a number of its members.² KEPCo asserted that it will be directly affected by both the proposed formula rate and the changes in the OATT and KEPCo and its members will or may be bound by any Commission order or activity in this proceeding and may be adversely affected thereby.³ Additionally, KEPCo

stated that representation of KEPCo's interests in this proceeding by existing parties is inadequate.⁴

4. The Commission has broad discretion to grant a petition for intervention if it is in the interest of justice, if the intervention will not impair the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceedings, and if the party has stated facts demonstrating its legal rights, duties, privileges, immunities or other legal interests may be substantially affected by the proceeding.⁵ Furthermore, at any time during a proceeding, the Commission may impose limitations on an intervenor's participation.⁶

5. The Commission finds and concludes that KEPCo has met the requirements of K.S.A. 77-521 and K.A.R. 82-1-225 and should be granted intervention.
