ORDER RESCHEDULING EVIDENTIARY HEARING AND ADJUSTING TESTIMONY DEADLINES

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings and conclusions:

On June 6, 2017, the Commission issued its Order Designating [a] Prehearing 1.

At the June 22, 2017, Prehearing Conference, all parties agreed to the following 2. procedural schedule:

Staff's Pre-filed Direct Testimony	Due: July 27, 2017
Operator's Pre-filed Direct Testimony	Due: August 3, 2017
Rebuttal Testimony	Due: August 10, 2017

Evidentiary Hearing before the Commission August 17, 2017

3. On June 29, 2017, the Commission adopted the above procedural schedule.²

4. On July 25, 2017, Commission Conservation Staff (Staff) filed a Motion stating that

"the parties jointly request that the evidentiary hearing in this docket . . . be rescheduled to September 21, 2017, and that the pre-filed testimony deadlines be adjusted accordingly" because a

resolution may be forthcoming without the need for a hearing.³ Staff stated that "[a] rescheduling would assist in the efficient resolution of this docket."⁴

6. Any settlement agreement the parties wish to present for Commission consideration shall be due by September 12, 2017.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

A. The modified procedural schedule set forth in paragraph 5 above is adopted. All other procedural matters remain as previously ordered.

B. The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if mailed service, from the date

this Order was served in which to petition for reconsideration.⁵

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
