The Presiding Officer finds and concludes as follows:

1. At an August 5, 2021, prehearing conference, all parties agreed to the following procedural schedule, which is hereby adopted:

Commission Staff Pre-Filed Direct Testimony	Due: September 27, 2021
Operator Pre-Filed Direct & Rebuttal Testimony	Due: October 25, 2021
Commission Staff Pre-Filed Rebuttal Testimony	Due: November 15, 2021
Evidentiary Hearing before the Commission:	To Be Determined

2. The Presiding Officer shall be in communication with the parties regarding further development of the procedural schedule, including scheduling of the evidentiary hearing.

3. Failure to submit pre-filed testimony may result in the Commission restricting the right to testify and present evidence at the evidentiary hearing. At the hearing, the Commission may limit the parties' direct and rebuttal testimony to the pre-filed testimony.

4. Any person requiring special accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities Act should notify the Commission at least 10 days before the scheduled hearing date.

5. Any party who fails to attend or participate in the evidentiary hearing or any other stage of this proceeding may be held in default under the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act.¹

6. Parties shall appear before the Commission via a Kansas-licensed attorney.²
