## APPLICATION OF COX KANSAS TELECOM FOR EXPEDITED REVIEW OF NUMBERING RESOURCE DENIAL

COMES NOW Cox Kansas Telecom ("Cox"), pursuant to the Expedited Review Process established by the Commission's Order No. 5 in Docket No.01-GIMT-552-GIT, and petitions the Commission to review and reverse the decision of the Thousands-Block Number Pooling Administrator ("PA") denying Cox the availability of certain numbering resources in the Salina, Kansas rate center. In support of its petition, Cox shows the Commission as follows:

- 1. Cox is an electing carrier providing intrastate local exchange service within the state of Kansas.
- 2. The Salina Regional Health Center ("Salina Regional"), in Salina, Kansas, is a Cox customer operating out of the Salina, Kansas rate center. To meet the growing needs of Salina Regional and ancillary facilities surrounding its location at 400 South Sante Fe, Salina, Kansas, Salina Regional is requesting additional numbers with a single common prefix. Salina Regional's current range of DID's does not have the capacity to fulfill Salina Regional's projected growth needs over the next 12 months.
  Per Salina Regional's growth plans, which anticipate rapid additions of

- new facilities and a new in-house communications system, a large block of new numbers will be needed in the coming months. Due to the numbering to be used in the new system, the NPA-NXX must be 785-xx8.
- 3. Salina Regional is requesting a 10,000 contiguous block of DID numbers from a 785-xx8-0000 to 785-xx8-9999 block range. NANPA will need to open a new NXX code for Cox to obtain the necessary blocks. Salina Regional has requested the numbers be available and operational as soon as is possible, thus the request for expedited consideration.
- 4. On June 16, 2016, Cox, on behalf of Salina Regional, requested 10 blocks (10,000 DID numbers) from the PA. (A copy of the customer's request is attached hereto as "Attachment 1" and is made a part hereof by this reference; Cox's original application is attached hereto as "Attachment 2" and is made a part hereof by this reference.)
- 5. Cox's request was subsequently denied by the PA because the request did not meet either of the two FCC established requirements for additional resources. (A copy of the PA's denial is attached hereto as "Attachment 3" and is made a part hereof by this reference.) Specifically, the PA stated that the application did not meet "the MTE and/or Utilization requirements," for the following reason: on the basis of the application, the PA concluded that Salina Regional would not exhaust already-assigned numbers within twelve months...
- 6. Salina Regional will not be returning any existing numbers.
- 7. Cox respectfully requests the Commission give this Petition expedited consideration, given Salina Regional's stated need for additional numbers as

part of its effort to provide expanded services to its patients, staff, and physicians.

WHEREFORE, Cox respectfully requests an Order of the Commission granting its Petition and overturning the PA's denial of Cox's numbering request so that Cox can meet the important needs of Salina Regional Health Center.
