I, Beau Rebel, being of lawful age and duly sworn state as follows:

1. I am employed by GBT Communications, Inc. (“GBT”) as General Manager and Chief Executive Officer.

2. In response to the Vantage Point Solutions, Inc., Revised Final Audit Report dated April 30, 2025, by this affidavit I hereby attest that GBT has performed the following actions:

- a. On March 14, 2025, GBT filed audit true-ups for KUSF fiscal years 26, 27, and 28, through January 31, 2025, to exclude fax revenue, voice mail revenue, and hosted phone sale revenue from revenues reported to the KUSF administrator as subject to the KUSF assessment;
- b. On March 27, 2025 GBT issued one-time billing credits to customers, on a pro rata basis, for a total of \$14,931.21;
- c. On February 26, 2025, GBT updated its billing system to exclude KUSF surcharge collection from fax revenues;
- d. On December 26, 2024, GBT updated its billing system to exclude KUSF surcharge collection from voicemail revenues;

- e. On December 26, 2024, GBT updated its KUSF reporting procedures to exclude voicemail, and hosted phone sale revenues;
- f. On February 26, 2025, GBT updated its KUSF reporting procedures to exclude fax revenues; and,
- g. On March 31, 2025, GBT provided VBPS with ten (10) customer bills supporting that the refund process has been completed.
