**COMPLIANCE FILING OF EVERGY KANSAS CENTRAL, INC. AND EVERGY
KANSAS SOUTH, INC.**

COME NOW Evergy Kansas Central, Inc. and Evergy Kansas South, Inc (together referred to as "EKC") and, pursuant to the Order Approving Unanimous Partial Settlement Agreement regarding Solar Facility and Non-Unanimous Partial Settlement Agreement regarding Natural Gas Facilities ("Order") issued in Docket No. 24-EKCE-207-PRE by the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission" or "KCC") on July 7, 2025, hereby submits its Compliance Filing regarding its Fuel Supply Plan and estimated potential rate impacts.

1. On July 7, 2025, the Commission issued its Order that approved a non-unanimous settlement in a predetermination docket filed by EKC related to EKC's construction and acquisition of 50% of a 710 MW combined cycle gas turbine located in Kansas near its Viola Substation ("Viola plant") and a 50% interest in a second 710 MW CCGT located near Hutchinson, Kansas ("McNew plant"), as well as the Kansas Sky solar facility.

2. In that order, the Commission included certain reporting requirements related to the two natural gas plants. In part, the Commission directed EKC to:

file its initial detailed fuel supply plan and an analysis of the impact fuel costs will have on customer rates in a compliance docket within 120 days of a final order being issued in this Docket. Revisions to this plan are expected as the plants near in-service, so the Commission directs Evergy to file these updates in the compliance

docket. The Commission finds firm natural gas transportation and supply arrangements to be absolutely paramount to the reliability of the CCGTs to serve EKC customers. Prior to beginning construction, Evergy is required to submit assurances that it has obtained firm gas transportation and supply arrangements.¹

3. In compliance with this directive, EKC is submitting its Initial Fuel Supply Plan as Attachment A to this pleading and is submitting its initial analysis of the fuel costs associated with the two natural gas facilities as Attachment B to this pleading.

4. As the Commission recognized in its Order, the projected in-service dates for these plants are several years away – 2029 for the Viola Plant and 2030 for the McNew Plant – and revisions to the Fuel Supply Plan between now and then are expected. As appropriate and in compliance with the Order, EKC will file any updates to the Plan in this docket if and when those revisions are made.

5. Additionally, because of the length of time until these in-service dates and the fact that many variables will change between now and then, the estimate of the fuel costs provided in Attachment B is an estimate based on the information reasonably available to EKC at this time. As additional information becomes available and the in-service dates get closer, EKC will be able to update the estimate of fuel costs for the Viola plant and the McNew plant and will provide those updates to the Commission.

WHEREFORE, EKC respectfully requests that the Commission accept its Compliance Filing and for such further relief as may be appropriate.

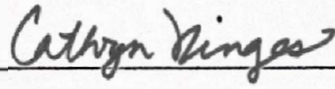

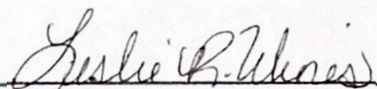
